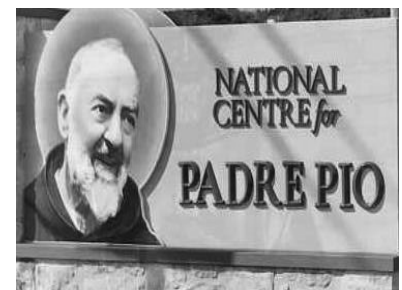

# Lenten Acts & Gospel Reading

Mar. 1, 2020	1 <sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent Matthew 4: 1-11 "Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil." Ask for the strength to resist temptation.
Mar. 2, 2020	Monday 1 <sup>st</sup> week of Lent Matthew 25: 31-46 "Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of Mine, you did for Me." Help care for someone in need.
Mar. 3, 2020	Tuesday 1 <sup>st</sup> week of Lent Matthew 6: 7-15 "If you forgive others their transgressions, your heavenly Father will forgive you." Offer a prayer on behalf of someone who has caused you pain and let go of grudges.
Mar. 4, 2020	Wednesday 1 <sup>st</sup> week of Lent Luke 11: 29-32 "...at the preaching of Jonah they repented and there is something greater than Jonah here." Confess your sins and ask God to help you become more obedient to His Word.
Mar. 5, 2020	Thursday 1 <sup>st</sup> week of Lent Matthew 7: 7-12 "Do to others whatever you would have them do to you." Extend the same kindness and forgiveness to others as Jesus has shown to you.
Mar. 6, 2020	Friday 1 <sup>st</sup> week of Lent Matthew 5: 20-26 "...go first and be reconciled with our brother, and then come and offer your gift." Reconcile with someone you have had a disagreement with.
Mar. 7, 2020	Saturday 1 <sup>st</sup> week of Lent Matthew 5: 43-48 "...love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you..." Pray for someone who has wronged you.
Mar. 8, 2020	2 <sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent Matthew 17: 1-9 "...then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.'" Listen attentive to those around you and recognize their best attributes.

## Last But Not Least



**This Sunday, we celebrate the 1st Sunday of Lent.** The church in her wisdom starts the First Sunday of Lent with the Gospel of Jesus being “driven” into the wilderness where He was tempted by Satan and was living among wild beasts. Immediately, after coming out of the Wilderness Jesus begins to preach that the “Kingdom of God is near, repent and believe in the Good News”. Isn't this what Lent is supposed to be all about?

Lent is closely related with the transition from winter to spring (which I am sure we are all waiting for those nice warm days). The word “Lent” comes from the Anglo-Saxon word for springtime, *lencten*. It describes the gradual lengthening of daylight after the winter solstice. From ancient times, fasting was a natural thing to do in preparing for the holiest of times. May you find time this Lent to renew and re-energize yourself during these holy days ahead! **Lent is also the primary time for celebrating the sacrament of Penance. I invite you to take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation which is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00pm to 4:30pm and 15 minutes after Mass and on Mondays from 6:30pm to 7:00pm and after the 7:00pm Mass.** I encourage you to take advantage of the many spiritual activities being offered here at St. Helena during this holy season of Lent.

On **Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 39 of our parish children will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time.** I ask that you keep these children and their parents in your prayers.

Finally, don't forget that Tithing is giving to God what belongs to God. I thank those who are using their church envelopes. **At Christmas, we wrap gifts for our family and friends. We are children of God. Consider wrapping your gift to God by putting your weekly contribution in an envelope with your name on the front.**
