# Coronavirus Course "101" for YOU

The word **"germ"** is a catch-all phrase that can mean any microscopic particle that can cause illness in humans. **"Bacteria"** are microscopic, single-celled organisms which live pretty much anywhere and everywhere. **"Virus"** is a small infectious agent that replicates only inside the living cells of an organism. **Viruses** can infect all types of life forms. Viruses can spread from person to person via respiratory droplets. When an infected person coughs or sneezes, close contacts can be infected. In addition, the virus can end up on doorknobs, elevator buttons and other surfaces. If you touch those surfaces and then touch your eyes, nose or mouth, you can become infected. There are no antibiotics for viruses...they don't work.

1. Wash your hands often with soap and water or hand sanitizer that contains alcohol for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Here are some suggestions to keep you healthy...
2. Sneeze and cough into tissues or the crook of your elbow.
3. Avoid close contact with people who are sick, especially people exhibiting respiratory symptoms and fever.
4. Stay home when you're sick.
5. Regularly and thoroughly clean surfaces, such as counter tops and doorknobs, with a disinfectant.
6. Drink plenty of water often...at least 4 ounces every half-hour to help wash toxins from your body.

1. Wash your hands with hand sanitizer when you come into church.
2. During the sign of peace, avoid shaking hands...bow or wave to the person.
3. Receive Holy Communion in your hand, please.
4. If you use tissues in church, please do not leave them in the pews or in the book holder.
5. We are suspending the chalice to Lectors and Extra-ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.
6. Thank you and pray for the victims of COVIC-19 and the safety of all of us.

Mar. 12, 2020	<b>Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> week of Lent ~ Luke 16: 19-31</b> <i>"Lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table." Where have you seen this parable playing out in your life?</i>
Mar. 13, 2020	<b>Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> week of Lent ~ Matthew 21: 33-43, 45-46</b> <i>"The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." What small and utterly outlandish thing is God asking of you today?</i>
Mar. 14, 2020	<b>Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> week of Lent ~ Luke 15: 1-3, 11-32</b> <i>"Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I no longer deserve to be called your son; treat me as you would treat one of your hired workers." Are there times when you have offered mercy grudgingly or withheld it because it had not been offered to you?</i>

Biblically a tithe means 10%. All are asked to consider returning 10% of our income to the Lord (5% to the parish, 5% to God's other charities: e.g. St. Helena Outreach Center, Food Bank) in gratitude. The spiritual practice of tithing disposes us to make God first in every area of our lives! The aim is to secure not the tithe, but the tither, not the gift, but the giver—for God!
