A message from Congressman Brendon Boyle

I'm reaching out to make you aware of some newly updated COVID-19 symptoms that were just released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Those new symptoms include: Chills, Repeated shaking with chills, Muscle Pain, Headache, Sore Throat, New loss of taste or smell The CDC cautions that at lea st two or more of the new

symptoms are consistent with COVID-19. Prior to these newly issued symptoms, the CDC had only listed THREE known symptoms: shortness of breath, cough and fever. As always, please consult your doctor or a medical professional if these symptoms become a concern for you.

Governor Wolf today released his plan to re-open the state. The Wolf administration will utilize a three-phase process to determine when counties and/or regions are ready to begin easing some restrictions on work, congregate settings, and social interactions. The Governor plans to proceed with returning to work cautiously. Throughout this process, the administration will have guidance in place to support best public health practices. This guidance will reinforce and build on existing worker and building safety orders. It will also be able to adapt to the changing nature of the pandemic, as well as lessons learned from communities that return to work strategically.

Last But Not Least



Today we celebrate the 5th Sunday of Easter Sunday and Mother's Day. In our gospel today Thomas says, "We don't know where you are going or how to get there." Jesus replies, "I am the way, the truth and the life." Philip asks Jesus to show them the Father. Jesus tells him that He and the Father are one- to see Jesus is to see the Father. We need to put ourselves in the shoes of the apostle Philip. Philip makes a simple request: "Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us." But if Philip thought that he was being humble in asking this, Jesus has other ideas. "Have I been with you for so long... and you still do not know me, Philip? ... How can you say, 'Show us the Father? Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me?" You can almost imagine Philip wide-eyed at Jesus' response, thinking that he'd asked for very little.

As we continue to deal with the coronavirus in our world and being isolated from other, I remind you during this time of social distancing to take advantage of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass that are on TV (channels are listed on page 2 of the bulletin) and on the Archdiocese's website. We will continue to live streamed our Vietnamese and Spanish Masses on you-tube. **Check out the parish website for digital copies of the bulletin.**
